 We have one more scheduled for the 8th April which I propose we cancel.
 We also have a mini ODE scheduled for 26th April which we need to discuss in general business.
- Certificate exams need to be schedule and prepared for we want an awesome pass rate again this year work hard riders and make your instructors proud of you
